Applications Development - design and code software applications on different computer platforms (PC, web and mobile)

Computer Support - work as the main computer technician in a company or as a member of a team providing help desk support

Cybersecurity – explore security practices, cyber defense techniques, and digital forensics related to the protection of today's networks and critical information systems

Network Management - set up, maintain, and manage computer networks in both a Windows and Linux environment
